

Haiti facts -  
Poorest country in the  
Western Hemisphere



- Infant mortality - 95 per 1000
- Average life expectancy  
-men = 48  
-women = 51
- Average income per year = \$500
- According to United Nations survey 56% of Haitians suffer from malnutrition
- A world survey says the people of Haiti live further from clean water than any other people in the world
- About 65% practice Voodoo
- 35% are Christian: up in the last decade from about 20%

The children are desperate

Nine of 10 children come to school without having had anything to eat.

Only half of 10 children will have anything to eat at home in the evening and only one of them will have enough to feel satisfied.

Until Trinity/HOPE arrives . . .  
They spend the day at school with nothing to eat, five out of 10 children will have nothing at all to eat in any 24 hour period.



Rust colored hair, blank stares, and tiny bodies are the telltale signs; the UN estimates that over 50% of the children of Haiti suffer from malnutrition

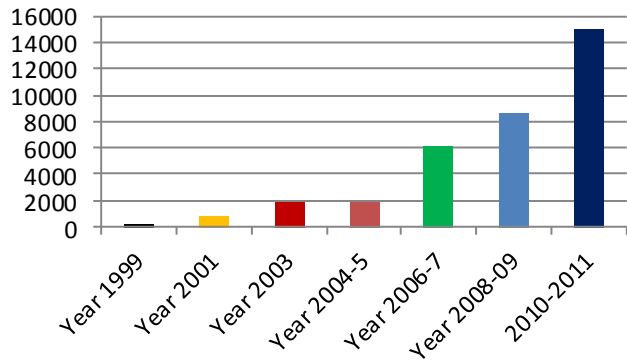
The solution is easy



A single meal (of rice or corn, beans and a sauce of oil, tomato paste, dried fish, and maggi) developed with the aid of the Vanderbilt Medical Center nutritionists cost approximately \$0.25.

This one daily meal totally changes the lives of these children.

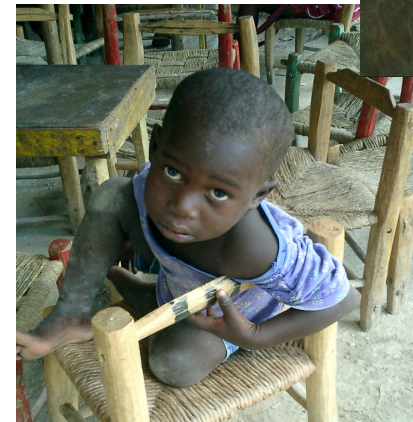
